

## Division Theme Art Contest Details

“Trust in the Lord with all your heart. Fais confiance au Seigneur de tout ton coeur.”

**Deadline for Entries: Monday, June 1, 2020**

### Criteria:

**THEME:** Artwork must depict the theme: “Trust in the Lord with all your heart. Fais confiance au Seigneur de tout ton coeur.” The overall winner must depict a connection between our Catholic faith and the theme.

**PLEASE NOTE:** Do not place the words of the theme on the artwork. The words of the theme will be added to the winning artwork digitally. However, the thought of artistic design should allow space for the theme to be added later.

**ORIENTATION:** Artwork must be created in **portrait orientation** to be eligible.

**PAPER:** Artwork should be done on clean white paper with no lines. Please use the entire space of paper.

**SIZE:** For the creation of the piece of art into poster format, we need the art to be in a specific dimension. If possible, please create the project in a **3:4** ratio such as 8 inches by 10 and 11/16 inches or 9 inches by 12 inches or 12 inches by 16 inches.

**MEDIUM:** Artwork can be in any medium (pencil crayons, markers, watercolours, pens, ink, charcoal, pastels, etc.). In addition, Photography and digital artwork can be submitted for the contest

**SUBMISSION:** Please submit your child’s art by taking a picture and sending the picture by email to LeeAnn Arsenault no later than the June 1 deadline. ### Contest Judging

- All artwork must depict our division theme: Trust in the Lord with all your heart.
- Each submission is judged on originality, artistic merit and expression of the theme. Submitted artwork must be an original creation. Please, no tracing or copying other’s artwork.
- The overall winner must depict a connection between our Catholic faith and the theme.
- Contest winner’s art may be selected as the faith theme poster for the 2020-2021 school year.
